This half term our topic is 'What a Wonderful World' and we will be exploring the life cycles of various species and taking a look at the life process of reproduction in plants and animals, including humans.



We will be completing our wow starter after a couple of days, just to allow the children to settle and complete some transition activities.

#### <u>English</u>

We are going to be exploring the implications of deforestation to rainforests around the world, by using 'The Great Kapok Tree' book and messages from the animals. The children will also be using the book and the film, 'The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe', to produce some pieces of writing.

#### <u>Maths</u>

This half term, the children will dive straight into their learning, as they take on their first maths topic of place value. They will be applying these skills later on when they move onto addition and subtraction.

#### <u>Science</u>

We will be learning about animal life cycles, their habitats, and then moving on to human growth and development. We have even got some new crawly friends that we are going to watch grow and learn about the process they go through.

#### Geography

In their geography work they will be looking at rainforests, climates and comparing countries.
