The Peri-ometer suggests the difficulty or challenge the

homework may offer. Every week you should attempt 1 challenge — make sure you choose different spice challenges (for example: mild, hot, extra hot.). This should be uploaded onto seesaw and we will share your homework with the class.



Hot: Can you create a fact file about the Olympic games? When did it start? Why is it important? How many events? What types of events? How many facts do you think you can find?	Hot: Can you create a Greek myth? Think about your setting, your mythical character and all the features you need to include.	Hot: Can you create Greek vase? You could use play doh, plasticine or clay. Remember to try and add the detail we have already discussed such as telling stories and the Greek patterns.	Hot: Can you research your favourite sporting player? Think about their early life (born, family, school life etc) You might want to draw a picture of them.
Medium: Can you design an Olympic stadium or a football stadium? You can use Minecraft, you can draw a stadium or you can even build a stadium using lego.	Medium: Can you research about a famous Greek God or Goddess? Who were they? Why were they famous? Were they good or evil?	Medium: Can you draw the Greek flag? You might need to research what the Greek flag looks like. Can you add 10 facts about Greece?	Medium: Can you report on a football match? After watching your favourite team (hopefully England), can you write a report on who played well, who needs to improve. What you thought of the match.
Mild: Can you research about Greek food? What did they eat in Ancient Greece? What do they eat now? Do they have a particular cuisine?	Mild: Can you complete 30 minutes on sumdog? Challenge a friend and make a note of it in your homework book.	Mild: Can you create your own mythical creature? You could draw this and spider diagram their features.
